The Yale French Department offers courses for all levels of study:

- Language (L1-L5), conversation, creative writing, and culture
- Literary translation
- Summer courses in Paris
- Business French and Medical French
- Upper-level seminars and lecture courses on novelists, poets, writers, history, film, visual arts, and literary and cultural movements spanning 10 centuries and 4 continents.

MAJORING IN FRENCH

The French major is a liberal arts major, designed for those who wish to study the French-speaking world in depth, as a primary or double major.

- **Standard Major:** 10 courses (FREN 160 and above) including the senior thesis
- **Intensive Major:** 12 courses including the one or two-term senior thesis
- **Translation Track:** standard major with minimum of 2 courses in French translation and a senior project (a substantial literature translation with a critical introduction).
- **Certificate of Advanced Language Study in French:** 4 courses above L4, including two L5-designated courses and one seminar at the 200-400 level.
- **Kenneth Cornell & James T. King Research Grants:** French majors are eligible to receive up to \$2000 for travel to a French-speaking country for senior essay research.

- Free private writing tutoring to students enrolled in French 170 and above
